

INFORMATION

Consequences:

If a student is not following classroom or school rules and/or procedures, they will first receive a verbal warning. If the behavior continues, the student will have a discussion with the teacher, that includes reteaching of expectations. If necessary, the parent will be contacted, and the behavior will be documented in Educator's Handbook as an "incident". If the behavior is persistent or beyond that of a classroom-managed consequence, it will be referred to administration and documented in Educator's Handbook as a "referral".
